OVER 1005 ENTRIES - THE FORMER REGATTA WINNERS START THEIR TRAINING BARCOLANA50 : 2 DAYS TO GO - ALL THE EVENTS FOR FRIDAY 5^{TH} OCTOBER

INITIATIVES - ENERGY FOR BURLO CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL TRIESTE'S TOWN COUNCIL PRESENTS THE BARCOLANA50 INITIATIVES

Trieste, 3rd October 2018 – Only 11 days to go to the regatta: Barcolana has already beaten all the records set in 2017 and there are already over 1000 entries.

TRAINING OF THE FORMER REGATTA WINNERS. THE MELGES: AN ALL WOMEN CREW – In the waters of the Gulf of Trieste, the former regatta winners started their training sessions. In the last few days, Spirit of PortoPiccolo sailed from the shipyard to Monfalcone and had its mast-step installed. Since yesterday it has been moored in PortoPiccolo in the mooring post of Furio Benussi's team. Way of Life (ex MaxiJena) has been training for a few days in Koper, on the other side of the Gulf of Trieste. E VAI, the spectacular sailboat owned by Lualdi, was one of the first SuperMaxi sailboats to register and is ready to race in its second Barcolana regatta. SuperMaxi yachts however aren't the only sailboats catching our attention: the category with the highest number of entries so far is the Meteor class, with 59 mono-hulls which are more than 6 m long. The biggest mono-hull of all is Melges 24 which will be sailed by a constellation of Olympic-stars: Giovanna Micol (captain), Giulia Conti, Francesca Clapcich, Flavia Tartaglini, Giulia Pignolo, and Sally Barkow. Melges 24 will be sailing to support Airc, the Italian Association for Cancer Research.

GRAND OPENING CEREMONY. THE EVENTS ON FRIDAY 5TH OCTOBER – After one year of hard work, we are almost there: only two days to the start of the Barcolana50 celebrations. On Friday 5th October, the opening of the exhibition by Trieste's Town Council, Samsung, and IKON "C'ero anche'io – La mia Barcolana" ("I was there too – My Barcolana experience") at Salone degli Incanti at 5 p.m. will mark the official kick off of the largest sailing celebration in the world. The next event will be the presentation of the book "Barcolana - Un mare di racconti" ("Barcolana – A sea of stories") by Mitja Gialuz and Alessandro Mezzena Lona, supported by Generali, and published by Giunti at 6 p.m. at Salone degli Incanti. The third event on schedule is the flag-hoisting ceremony of Barcolana FUN by Siram by Veolia, the regatta raced by the Under 19 young sailors from Lega Italiana Vela (Italian Sailing League). At 9 p.m. the theatre Teatro Miela will stage the



















play "Cinquanta Venti – La Barcolana dal principio" ("Fifty winds – Barcolana since the beginning"). Right from the morning, the buildings along the Rive seafront, all dressed with Barcolana50 bunting be offering spectators a unique view.

CHARITY – Barcolana and its partners have been collecting funds for several charity initiatives. On 6th October, Bob Sinclar will be performing in the concert organised by Barcolana and Despar for Trieste's Children's Hospital Burlo Garofolo, the hospital that helps all the mothers and children from the Friuli Venezia Giulia region; visitors and the junior sailors were involved in the "Winch game" designed by Gruppo Hera - EstEnergy as part of the charity project "lo sto con il Burlo" (I support Burlo). The purpose of the game is to spin the winch - the mechanical device used by sailors to wrap ropes – as fast as you can and the higher the number of spins in 30 seconds the higher the donation Gruppo Hera EstEnergy will give to Trieste's Children's Hospital Burlo Garofolo. The game can be played every day at the group's stand from 6th to 14th October in Piazzetta Barcolana. On Wednesday 10th October, Barcolana Chef, the culinary event of Barcolana organised in collaboration with illy, will also be donating its profits to Burlo Garofolo Children's Hospital.

Trieste's Town Council has organised a series of press conferences on the initiatives brought forth by the other FVG Town Councils regarding logistics, organisation, and safety on land. Trieste's Town Council has always been one of the closest supporters of the Sailing Club Società Velica di Barcola e Grignano in the organisation of Barcolana. To mark Barcolana50, Trieste's Town Council has organised several special activities involving Trieste's museums and public libraries.

The Frecce Tricolori Airshow will be another special event to mark Barcolana's 50th anniversary. The Italian Air Force aircrafts will fly over the starting line of Barcolana50 to Piazza Unità d'Italia before the start of the regatta.
