**Trieste, 9 October 2018**– Sun and light winds have filled Barcolana's social inclusion day when hundreds of young disabled people have been the protagonists at sea and on land, racing the regatta or taking part in events at Salone degli Incanti.

DAY5 at Barcolana has seen a rise in the number of entries to over 1630. Also, two of the most awaited yachts moored along the Trieste waterfront: Viriella, the 116 ft vessel, ambassador of the Once Ocean Foundation and the largest sailboat to have ever entered Barcolana, and the defender Spirit of Portopiccino. The great festive atmosphere gets underway at the Barcolana Village, many activities have started and numerous SuperMaxis have already moored.

**WE WANT THE SAILORS' SKINS** -Fill in the questionnaire! This is the request made by Iris Zalaudek to all sailors in the framework of a campaign to screen the sailors' (and public's) skin. Over 300 people turned up at the stand in the Barcolana Village to learn more about the best practices to protect their skin from the sun: *"But we expect more from sailors - explains Dr Zalaudek – We want them to fill in an online questionnaire to help us with an important scientific research study that we are conducting on skin that is constantly exposed to the sun". "Barcolana has chosen to spread the message promoted by Iris – says SVBG chairman Mitja Gialuz - It's important that sailors spend two minutes filling in this questionnaire which will help prevention and scientific research! **SPIRIT OF PORTO PICCOLO** – Barcolana's defender has moored along the seafront, next to the quay Molo Audace, at mooring number 1. On Thursday at 5.45 pm, its skipper Furio Benussi will hand back the Barcolana Trophy to the organizers during a ceremony at the team's stand. The Trophy will be kept by the organizers until the next award.

**CQS IN TEMPUS FUGIT** – In the afternoon, at 5.30 pm, the challenger started presenting its crew, made up of local, New Zealander and Australian sailors. The great protagonist, skipper Ludde Ingvall, has said he was *"amazed by Trieste, by the bubbly atmosphere and by expectations, I am very curious"*.

**VIRIELLA** – In the meantime, at 8 o'clock, Viriella has reached Trieste. Ambassador of the One Ocean Foundation bearing the burgee of the Yacht Club Costa Smeralda, it is the largest vessel to have ever entered Barcolana and will be steered by Mauro Pelaschier. Onboard the vessel a press conference will give more insight into the boat and the One Ocean project.

**TRIESTE'S NAUTICAL SCHOOL AND THE FOLLOW ME PROJECT** – The SVBG chairman and Donatella Bigotti, headmistress of Trieste's Nautical School, have presented the new Follow me edition of the project that is the feather in the cap of the collaboration between the school and Barcolana. Seventy pupils will get some hands-on experience at the moorings along the waterfront under the supervision of the Auxiliary Coast Guard. *"This is a significant project – commented Mitja Gialuz – because education and training are key objectives of our event. The pupils of the Nautical School can live a unique experience, working in close contact with the Auxiliary Coast Guard, the Port Authorities, the organizers of Barcolana and, most of all, they will throw a line with many sailors that reach Trieste after a long navigation"*.

**NAUTICAL ACADEMY OF THE ADRIATIC – COURSES NOW OPEN** Barcolana also promotes the Accademia Nautica dell'Adriatico (Nautical Academy of the Adriatic) which has just opened its new building in the old Arsenal of the Austrian Lloyd. The prestigious School, directly connected to the Nautical School, has launched the first edition of the Course on Naval Design with Fincantieri. The course will offer 24 pupils the unique opportunity to work with one of the largest shipbuilders in the world. Fincantieri's Deputy-Chairman and HR Deputy-Manager Carlo Giordani explained that: *"we have conceived this specialisation course in the naval-mechanical sector to face our company's increasing workload"*.

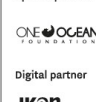
