BARCOLANA50 MARKS A NEW RECORD OF PARTICIPANTS 2 MILES ADDED TO THE START LINE

FINAL EVENT: "SUSTAINABLE SCHOOL" BY SIRAM BY VEOLIA - PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

Trieste, 12th October 2018 – Barcolana50 marked a new record of participants today at 10:19 a.m. when entry No. 2012 finalised its registration. The new record in the number of entries has brought great excitement among the Organizing Committee in the Sailing Club Società Velica di Barcola e Grignano, who has been working on this event for months. "We are celebrating Barcolana and Trieste, the city which believes in this event and in the way it tells the story of Trieste's maritime tradition" – commented Mitja Gialuz, chairman of the Sailing Club SVBG.

The number of entries reached 2,305 at 7:30 p.m., but registrations are still opened until 8 p.m. and tomorrow from 9 a.m.

In line with Trieste's hospitality and its maritime tradition, the Barcolana celebrations continue to unfold along the Rive Seafront, on the piers and in the Sailing Clubs. Given the high number of visitors, the Local Government Office has decided to turn the main street along the Rive Seafront into a pedestrian area. The Race Committee has decided to add an extra 550 m to the starting line and add more space to the pre-start side of the starting line to adapt to the change in position of Mark P1, which is now located at the end of Miramare.

TODAY'S REGATTAS – A light wind will favour the many events scheduled for today, which will take place against the backdrop of the tall ship Nave Vespucci, moored in Bacino di San Giusto.



















The final regatta of the second edition of Barcolana Fine Art Sails, the event organised by the Sailing Club Società Velica di Barcola e Grigano, was raced this morning

by Star yachts equipped with hand-painted sails. Guest star: Dario Noseda, the Italian skipper who sailed across the Atlantic Ocean aboard a Star yacht and who couldn't miss the opportunity to watch a regatta raced by his favourite category. Overall winners: Guglielmo Danelon and Max Gazzetta (Yacht Club Adriaco) aboard Basilisco, who scored first and second in the single regattas; second: Semi-Semi (Yacht Club Adriaco), and third: Longhi-Simoni (STV).

BARCOLANA INVITATIONAL, VENEZIA GIULIA COLLIO CUP – Ten J70 mono-hull crews from local sailing clubs from Muggia to Grado raced in this year's successful edition of Barcolana Invitational, the level-playing field regatta sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce of Venezia Giulia. Because of the low winds, the pace of the sailboats racing in the regatta wasn't as fast as expected. Overall winner: Società Triestina della Vela, which scored first and fourth in the single regattas; second: Stefano Campanacci of the Italian Naval League – Division of Trieste; third: Diporto Nautico Sisitiana with helmsman Alberto Leghissa.

FINCANTIERI CUP – CETILAR SAILING SERIES M32 – The last two of the four regattas of the Fincantieri Cup were raced today. The official ranking of the European Circuit: GAC Pindar first; the Swedish catamaran Vikings second, and Vitamina Veloce third.

B50 VS NIBBIO REGATTA BY DHL: RACING FOR 50 YEARS – The end of a day full of regattas was marked by a celebration of the history and the maritime tradition in Trieste. Nibbio, the only historical sailboat to compete in all 50 editions of Barcolana, raced against Barcolana50, the traditional *Passera* sailboat built this winter and launched in July by the Sailing Club SVBG with SIAD. The regatta was raced in the Gulf of Trieste against the backdrop of the other sailboats lined up along the Rive Seafront waiting to take part in Sunday's regatta. Despite the light wind which didn't allow the sailboats to race at full speed, the regatta was an event filled with significance, passion, and respect for the local maritime tradition. The yellow gennakers of the two sailboats sponsored by DHL, deep believer in the values promoted in this race, were hoisted to take advantage of even the slightest wind gusts. Even though it was meant to be a non-competitive historical reenactment, Nibbio and Barcolana50 raced with all their strength, until Barcolana50 crossed the finish line just a few centimeters before Nibbio.



















"SUSTAINABLE SCHOOL" BY SIRAM BY VEOLIA AND BARCOLANA PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The prize-giving ceremony of the "Sustainable school" project was held today in Piazzetta Barcolana to reward the best projects designed by students of the high school Istituto Tecnico Volta in Trieste, for a sustainable and energy-efficient school.

The winning students who designed the best energy efficiency projects were prized with € 3000 (1st place), € 1,250 (2nd place), and € 750 (3rd place) by Siram by Veolia, Barcolana50 main sponsor, in Piazzetta Barcolana. The project of a *School cogeneration plant* designed by the group Meccatronici (class V – I) won the first prize. The second prize was given to the *Lab energy revamping* project for the school's construction department designed by class IV A specializing in Construction, Environment, and Territory. *Pocket smart Room*, a project on the creation of a class light and heating system designed by class V E from the IT department, was awarded with the 3rd prize. Moreover 6 winning students with the best grades will receive scholarships and test their knowledge in the framework of a "study + internship" programme in one of Siram's North-East offices. During the internship, experts will provide students with all the help they need.

"We are grateful to all the students, teachers, and the principals of the high school Istituto Tecnico Volta for their work. This high school is Trieste's point of reference in the training of technicians and during the years we've always been proud of the highly qualified technicians we've hired from this school. We have managed the maintenance, energy supplies, and services of many public and private buildings in the region for more than 50 years, therefore we've asked students to commit as much as we do and find innovative solutions to create a more sustainable school" — said Paolo Maltese, head of the Business Department of Siram by Veolia North-East

"Students were excited to take part in our initiative and they felt they had an important responsibility. We have always been training highly qualified technicians and this project gave us the chance to allow students to live a professional experience. Our students have been involved in the creation of a practical project and thanks to the technical and professional skills they acquired in this high school, they were able to design a project for an innovative, comfortable, sustainable school. Sustainability and technical skills are the values we share with Siram, which are the pillars of this important connection between our high school and this business" – Commented Clementina Frescura, principal of the high school Istituto Tecnico Volta.

Barcolana together with the Italian company Siram, organized a contest involving more than 200 pupils aged between 17 and 18 from 11 classes of the high school Istituto Tecnico Volta in Trieste. From the 18th to 21st September, the pupils, with the help of their teachers and of experts from Siram, worked on the project "Sustainable school". To win the contest, the pupils had to design practical projects implementing the energy efficiency measures laid down in the Conto Termico 2.0 to make their schools energy efficient.

Barcolana Classic, Siad Trophy is the regatta for vintage, classic and spirit-of- tradition vessels organized by the Sailing Club Società Velica di Barcola e Grignano (SVBG) in collaboration with Yacht Club Adriaco. The event is a tribute to the ladies of the sea, from large yachts that once sailed the oceans to Losinj's typical small boats, known as passere, from boats carefully restored by local shipwrights to the ones designed by Carlo Sciarrelli. This year's guest star will be the passera sailing yacht Barcolana50, designed by the SVBG to mark Barcolana's 50 th anniversary. Barcolana Classic, Siad Trophy will start with an impressive parade at 10:30 a.m. in the waters of Piazza Unità d'Italia, followed by the regatta at 11:30 a.m.. LA MARINAREZZA BOCCHESE

"Marinarezza" is the name of the most ancient naval corporation and precursor of what is commonly known as "yacht club". Now a UNESCO world heritage site, "Marinarezza" was founded in 809 in Kotor, Montenegro, and is the most ancient maritime organization to safeguard and bequeath maritime traditions. Members of "Marinarezza" will perform traditional age-old dances to pay tribute to Barcolana and to celebrate the seafaring spirit of the Adriatic.
